

MAGNETIC WIRELESS POWER BANK

KIKOO Mag 5000mAh Qi2 Certified Magnetic Power Bank

A Qi2 certified 5000mAh magnetic pack that snaps to the back of a MagSafe iPhone and charges it at 15W wirelessly, or at PD 20W over Type-C. Model KIKOOP33Qi2MAG-5000.



Overview

Qi2 certification is the point of this product. A Qi2 pack aligns magnetically and negotiates 15W with the phone, which is where the older 7.5W magnetic packs lost customers. At 5000mAh it is the slim-profile option: it adds a top-up rather than a full day, which is exactly what a phone user wants clipped to the back of a handset in a pocket. The aluminium alloy, ABS and PC housing carries a 20W Type-C port for cable charging in and out, and a 5W output for TWS earphones. Published certifications are Qi2, CE, FCC, ROHS, MSDS, IEC62368-1, UL2056 and UN38.3.

- Magnetic alignment holds the coil in position, which is where most of the efficiency in wireless charging is won or lost
- 5000mAh keeps the pack thin enough to stay attached to the phone in a pocket
- PD 20W over Type-C for the times a cable is faster
- Published battery-safety documentation set: IEC62368-1, UL2056, UN38.3, MSDS

Use Guide

- Attach to a MagSafe iPhone, or to an Android phone in a magnetic (Qi2 ready) case
- Thick or metal-backed cases reduce magnetic hold and coupling; test with the case the customer actually uses
- Use the Type-C port when speed matters; wireless is the convenience path, not the fastest one
- Recharge the pack through the same Type-C port at up to 20W
- Shipping is regulated: UN38.3 is on file and the MSDS goes with the booking

- Attached to a MagSafe iPhone through a day of navigation and camera use
- Retail bundles sold alongside Qi2-ready Android handsets in a magnetic case
- Travel kit where a slim top-up matters more than total capacity
- Charging a TWS earbud case from the 5W output
