

# Chinese Granite Colour Reference

Seven granite colour references exported as tile and slab, described by colour and grain with the information needed to specify an order.

| Reference     | Colour and grain                          | Typical use                                                                       |
|---------------|-------------------------------------------|-----------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Granite KG-01 | Pale pink-beige, even fine grain          | Interior floor and wall cladding; Kitchen and vanity worktops                     |
| Granite KG-06 | Strong orange-red with dark flecks        | Feature cladding and entrance surrounds; Monumental and memorial stone            |
| Granite KG-02 | Pink-grey, medium crystalline grain       | Floor tiles in commercial and residential interiors; External cladding and paving |
| Granite KG-03 | Light grey-white with dark flecks         | Large-format interior floors; Contemporary kitchen and bathroom surfaces          |
| Granite KG-04 | Very light grey, fine even grain          | Large uninterrupted floor areas; Cladding where uniformity is specified           |
| Granite KG-05 | Grey-pink, medium grain, warm undertone   | Interior flooring and stair treads; External cladding and paving                  |
| Granite KG-07 | Dark grey-green with heavy black flecking | Contrast borders, bands and thresholds; High-traffic entrance and lobby flooring  |

## Specifying a granite order

### Sizes and finishes are confirmed per enquiry

The source catalogue lists these stones by colour reference. Tile size, slab dimension, thickness and finish are confirmed against your requirement before quotation and are marked TBC here rather than estimated.

### Approve a physical sample

Colour on a screen is not reliable for natural stone. Samples are sent for approval before production begins.

### Order one installation from one batch

Granite varies between blocks. On a large floor that variation is the difference between an accepted and a rejected job.

### Finish affects slip resistance

Honed and flamed finishes give more slip resistance than polished, which matters on wet floors and external steps.

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
