

RFQ Checklist

The eight data points that let us quote a pump or part correctly the first time.

Send These Eight Things

Item	Why It Matters
Photograph of the nameplate	A photograph avoids the transcription errors that cause wrong parts
Full model code	Identifies the family, frame, displacement, port variant, shaft and rotation
Part required	Complete pump, cartridge kit, rotary group or a single part
Quantity	One piece for a repair or a stocking quantity. Both are welcome
Machine make and model	Helps confirm the variant when the nameplate is damaged or missing
Delivery port or address	So the quotation includes a realistic freight arrangement
Urgency	Tell us if a machine is down and we will check stock before anything else
Documentation needed	Certificates and reports are easier to produce during manufacture than after it

If the Nameplate Is Missing

- Photograph the pump from four sides including the mounting face and the shaft end
- Measure the mounting bolt spacing across the diagonal rather than between adjacent holes
- Note the port thread or flange size
- Tell us which way the shaft turns viewed from the drive end
- Give the machine make, model and approximate year

What Happens Next
