It handles 150 to 1200 crates per hour in SUS304 and washes fruit crates, bread crates and milk product crates, with steam heating, electrical heating and hot water versions available to suit the utilities already on site.

A crate washing machine handling 150 to 1200 crates per hour, built in SUS304 stainless steel and available in steam heating, electrical heating or hot water types. It washes fruit crates, bread crates and milk product crates for dairy, fruit juice and beverage plants, and is supplied with a monthly production capacity of 100 units against a minimum order of one unit.

Key benefits

Throughput Range of Eight to One. 150 to 1200 crates per hour across the range means the machine is matched to your line rather than to the middle of a catalogue. Crate washing is a bottleneck only when it is undersized.

SUS304 Throughout. The wash chamber lives in hot water and detergent all day. SUS304 is what keeps it serviceable rather than corroding at the weld lines.

Three Heating Options. Steam, electrical and hot water types are all available, so the machine connects to whatever utility the plant already runs.

Energy-Saving Operation. Energy use in a crate washer is dominated by heating the wash water. The design priority here is saving that energy across the shift.

Washing returnable milk product crates in a dairy • Cleaning fruit crates before processing • Washing bread crates in a bakery distribution operation • Cleaning crates in a fruit juice production plant • Beverage plants handling returnable transit packaging • Food plants required to demonstrate crate hygiene
