Jump And Break Cues

Three-section maple jump and break cues with large tips, built for the shot that damages a playing cue.



What This Family Is For

A break shot and a jump shot both punish a playing cue: the impact is higher, the tip is harder and the ferrule takes a load it was never tapered for. The cues in this family are built as three-section jump and break cues so one stick covers both shots and the house cues stay intact.

Why Buyers Choose This Range

- Three-section construction so one cue serves both jump and break
- Large tip diameters published per model, including 13.8 mm
- Maple construction named rather than described as hardwood
- Published as factory-supplied and ready to ship
- Packs alongside the playing cue range in the same order

Problems It Solves

- House cues break down early because players break with them
- A jump shot lifts the ball but splits the ferrule of a playing cue
- Break cues arrive with tips too soft to survive a season of breaks
- Three-section cues arrive with sections that do not interchange
- A room has no dedicated break cue, so the table takes the damage instead

Who It Is For

- Pool halls protecting their house cue stock
- Tournament rooms that need a dedicated break stick per table
- Distributors completing a cue range with break and jump cues
- Training rooms teaching the jump shot
- Retailers selling break cues as an accessory purchase

Application Scenarios

- One break cue held at each table in a commercial room
- Trick-shot and exhibition play
- Retail bundles pairing a playing cue with a break cue

Materials

- Named on the source listing: Maple
- Material substitutions are raised before production rather than after arrival

Manufacturing Process

1. Maple selected for the three-section build
2. Sections turned and joints machined to interchange
3. Hard break tip fitted to the published diameter
4. Assembly checked at both full and shortened length
5. Finished and marked
6. Inspected and packed

Customisation Options

- Logo printed on the case and the packing, per the source FAQ
- Packing customised to retail, counter or bulk supply
- Colour options where the product publishes them
- Sample produced and approved before the production run
- Low minimum order quantity, with sample orders accepted

Certification Standards

Production follows . Certificates are sent per product on request.

Questions Buyers Ask

What is the difference between a jump cue and a break cue?

A break cue is heavier and stiffer to transfer power into the rack. A jump cue is shorter and lighter so the shaft can be raised steeply. The three-section cues here are built to serve both by removing a section.

What tip diameter is published for these cues?

13.8 mm on the models that publish a figure. A break tip is deliberately hard, because a soft tip absorbs the energy the break is meant to deliver.

Can break cues carry our logo?

Yes, OEM applies across the range. Logo position on a three-section cue is confirmed at sampling because the joint positions limit the print area.

Are they in stock?

The source listings publish these as ready to ship. Current availability is confirmed by email before the order is placed.

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
