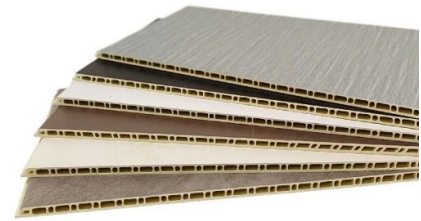

PVC Panel

PVC wall panels and PVC ceiling panels for interior decoration, in wood plastic or stone plastic composite, with customized colours and sizes and PVC content specified from 40% to 70% on the ceiling range.



What This Family Is For

Two products for two jobs: an integrated wall panel that replaces paint and tile on the wall, and a ceiling panel that solves the kitchen and bathroom ceiling, where it weighs about a third of ceramic tile.

Materials

- Bamboo wood fibre, solid wood and polymer composite options.
- Wood plastic or stone plastic composite body.
- Marble and wood grain surface prints.

Manufacturing Process

1. Extrusion - The wood flour and polymer compound is extruded through the profile die and pulled to the published section.
2. Hot and cold pressing - The decor veneer is laminated to the panel face and bonded under hot then cold pressing.
3. Inspection - Section, colour and surface are checked against the order spec during the run, not only at the end.
4. Packing and loading - Boards are bundled, film wrapped or cartoned and palletised for container loading.

Customisation Options

- Panel size made to your room dimensions
- Colour and surface pattern including marble and wood grain

- Material choice between wood plastic and stone plastic composite
- OEM packaging and sample boards

Certification Standards

Production follows . Certificates are sent per model and destination market on request.

What is the difference between the wall panel and the ceiling panel?

The wall panel is an integrated wall board in wood plastic or stone plastic composite. The ceiling panel is a lighter PVC panel made for humid rooms.

How long does the wall panel last?

Service life exceeds 15 years for the bamboo wood fibre and PVC material.

What PVC percentages are available on the ceiling?

40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65 and 70%.

Where are they made?

Shandong, China.

How are the ceiling panels packed?

In PE shrink film or cartons.

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
